I am filling in while Rabbi Joshua is on vacation this week and felt like we could all use a little positivity to end the week!

Recently our office received a phone call from Reno Apartments in Los Angeles. We had provided a security deposit for a client last year, and now that client was moving out. The security deposit had to be returned to the same entity that paid it, so they called to ask who they should make the check payable to.

Ryan, our Director of Eviction Prevention and Rental Assistance, looked up the client in the Los Angeles homeless management database and was happy to discover this client has now qualified for long-term emergency housing funding from another agency, meaning they will have housing security for the foreseeable future!

We are delighted that we were able to protect our client from homelessness in the short term, and thrilled that they have secured long-term help to remain housed. But we are also very pleased that we were able to help them essentially for free, and that the money temporarily used for their security deposit can now be used to help someone else!



On a personal and professional note, I spent the last six months as a part of the fantastic <u>Leadership Pasadena</u> program. Months of connecting with other professionals in the local area, neuro-science based leadership development, a dive into Pasadena's rich history, and a community service project all culminated with graduation last week (photo of my cohort above provided by Sonia Tapia Photography). Special thanks to FID Board member Ervin Galvan, owner of <u>We Olive Pasadena</u>, for supporting this opportunity as I expanded our network of community collaborators on behalf of Friends In Deed.

Thank you for everything you do to help support us in *doing together what we cannot do alone! Our hard-working staff will be taking this 4th of July off, so all regular services will resume Tuesday, July 5th.
