Dear Friend,

I want to give a huge thank you to Merria, our awesome Director of Development, for filling in to write this message for the past few weeks. While I rarely use this email to talk about myself personally, I thought that my absence can be related to the people we serve at Friends In Deed. Like millions of other people, I came down with COVID - a moderate case, keeping me in bed for 11 days feeling quite sick. And even now, a week after testing negative, I am still tired and have low energy. I only tell you this because I was thinking about so many people who have been sick who didn't have the resources and blessings that I, and many of us, are fortunate to have.

I am thinking about Linda, a 60-year-old woman living in her car; I am thinking about Luisa, a mother of four staying in a motel looking for a job and caring for her kids; I am thinking about the Johnsons, who are struggling to pay their rent and not be evicted; and I am thinking about the tens of thousands of others who, if they get sick, face disaster. Like many of you, I have a home to rest and recover; I have a spouse who could work at home to care for me; I have healthcare for medication and doctors' advice; I have a job with benefits and sick leave; namely, I have security to be sick, recover and not worry about anything else. So, it is for Linda, Luisa, and the Johnsons that we are here to provide as much help as we can in times of great need which, for many, is each and every day.



And as you know, we cannot do any of this without your help. It is December, which means now is the time for our Winter Appeal, the largest and most important fundraising campaign of the year. We had an awesome start this past week, as 66 wonderful people donated \$8,353 for Giving Tuesday - thank you! And a special shoutout to our very lucky cookie winners, Jeanne Martin and Janet Chunn.
