Like so many of us, our FID families face many financial challenges but unlike many of us, they have a higher degree of difficulty in overcoming these challenges. Economic instability is still a major hurdle for our families and this makes it even more difficult for families for big events, like the start of a new school year. This is why we consider our annual "Back-To-School" event such an important one.

Last year, you, our Friends In Deed family, helped us to provide almost 400 backpacks and school supply bags to the young students in our Food Pantry community. It was a huge success and everyone that came for a backpack and school supplies, received them.

This year, your participation is more important than ever. We expect to see as many students come for backpacks as last year, if not more. Your help and support are imperative to the success of this special event. We cannot do it without you. We hope that you will join us in this effort!

On two consecutive Saturdays, August 3 & 10, we will be distributing backpacks and supplies to families in our community. We ask you to help us by dropping off donations to the Friends In Deed house, located at 444 E. Washington Blvd., Pasadena, CA 91104 (on the corner of Washington Blvd. and Los Robles Ave.).

Donations will be accepted starting Saturday, July 6. Please plan to bring the donations on one of the following days:

Thursday – July 11, 18, & 25, from 1:30p to 4:30p Friday – July 12, 19, & 26, from 9:00a to 3:00p Saturday – July 6, 13, 20, & 27, from 9:00a to 3:00p

- 1. Please avoid all red and all blue backpacks. This is very important to our schools.
- 2. Backpacks should be sturdy enough to handle the rigors of a student's day and the tremendous supply of books students heft around, especially high school students.
- 3. The school supplies needed are recommended by the Pasadena/Altadena area schools and the list is included below.
- 4. Empty backpacks and school supplies must be delivered to Friends In Deed by <u>Friday</u>, <u>July 21</u>, <u>2023</u> at the latest, in order to be included in the distribution.

- Pens blue and black
- Pencils, including #2 yellow 6-sided for younger grades; mechanical pencils
- Erasers
- Zipper pouch for pens and pencils (3 holed to go in binders)
- Colored Markers (NO Sharpies or Permanent Markers)
- Highlighters, all colors
- Colored Pencils
- Sharpeners (must hold shavings)
- Colors Crayons (prefer Crayola Brand)
- 2 Pocket Folders (prefer poly folders)
- Calculators
- Dry Erase Markers
- Student scissors (such as Fiskar)
- Rulers (metric & customary)
- 3" x 5" index cards
- Glue Sticks (many schools prefer the sticks to bottles of glue)
- 3 Ring Binders 1"- 3"
- Tab Dividers for Binders
- Staplers and staples
- Copy paper 1 pkg per family
- Tissue/Kleenex small packages that can easily fit into backpacks
- Hand sanitizer bottles
- Disinfecting wipes packets
