Bad Weather Shelter

Beginning January 15th, Pasadena residents experiencing unsheltered homelessness can visit Trinity Lutheran Church (997 E. Walnut Street, Pasadena CA 91106) every Monday and on weather-activated nights. Enrollment is between 7 and 9pm. The shelter will operate on cold or rainy nights - when the weather is forecast to be 40 degrees or below, or there is more than 40% chance of rain or wind. The shelter will provide a hot meal, cot to sleep on, restrooms, and additional access to case management and other services as needed.
