Nora, who is an MSW intern in TWR, recently established a partnership with My Dog Is My Home, a national nonprofit dedicated to expanding access to shelter for individuals experiencing homelessness and their companion animals. They provided insight to TWR on how we can better support our guests with these incredibly important animals. This led to us providing outside crates through the Pasadena Humane Society, as well as food and bedding for our clients' loved ones.

My Dog Is My Home is celebrating its 10-year anniversary, and inquired if we knew of any people who could potentially share a story at their event. Lindsey, Jane and Jenny knew Denise would be a perfect fit! Since being housed last year, Denise has been expanding her advocacy efforts with opportunities through FID and the city of Pasadena. My Dog Is My Home provided speech training and compensation to the speakers.

Last Saturday, Denise shared about her dog, Arwen, and how she truly saved her life when they were unhoused. Denise gave a huge shout out to Friends In Deed for getting them off the streets and into a safe home. Of course, TWR attended the event to support Denise and cheer her on! We are excited to see where her public speaking and advocacy journey takes her.

Golfing for Good is taking place on Friday, April 5, 2024 at Brookside Golf Club. Registration is now open!




Warm Clothing Needed
