Dear Friend,

I have heard Tim, Director of the Food Pantry, talk about the pantry as three communities: volunteers, clients, and a combination of volunteers and clients. Here is what he means. Many of our volunteers come on specific days and times, so there are the Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday crews, and they know each other; many of the clients come on specific days and times so they know each other; and many of the volunteers know the clients that come during their shifts. Volunteers have become friends, clients are excited to see the other people that come when they do, and volunteers and clients look forward to seeing one another.

When I asked for some examples, Eva, our Food Pantry Manager, shared some lovely moments. "Shoppers help us do the lottery– there is always someone willing to hold on to the tickets after we call the numbers, and another person holds the pitcher where we keep the tickets before we call the numbers out. Sometimes, we have to put up canopies out front because of the rain or sun. When we go out with the canopies, it is very common for folks to get up and help us put them up. The pantry community also helps each other. They will explain how the lottery works to new people, and share important information such as our hours and events with each other." It is truly a unique part of our pantry operations: we don't just offer healthy food, we offer friendship, camaraderie, and a sense of warmth, with compassion and dignity.
