Dear Friend,

Janice is a 62-year-old woman living on her Social Security retirement. She had been in an emotionally and mentally abusive relationship and was also looking for work to increase her income. Fortunately, she took the initiative to locate an affordable rental unit in Pasadena that allowed her to move out of an unhealthy situation. Janice reached out to our Eviction Prevention and Rental Assistance (EPRA) program for move-in assistance. She is one of the fortunate Pasadena residents who was able to secure housing in one of the new affordable housing developments in the city. Although her rent is less than \$600 per month, given her fixed income, it was difficult for her to come up with the funds needed to pay for the security deposit, first month's rent, and all the other expenses related to moving. Moving is expensive for all of us and, for those living on a limited budget, the cost of a move can be prohibitive. EPRA's support helped Janice get out of a bad situation and averted the risk of her losing housing and ending up on the street.

On a separate topic, I imagine that many of you have been following the recent Supreme Court decision in Grants Pass v. Johnson, which allows cities to punish unhoused people for sleeping on the streets, even if they have nowhere else to go. In the coming weeks, I am going to dig into this important decision on my podcast, especially regarding how it will affect the streets of our city. 
