As I mentioned last week, the recent Supreme Court decision Grants Pass v. Johnson now allows cities, counties, and states to punish unhoused people for sleeping on the streets, even if they have nowhere else to go. And, just yesterday, Governor Newsom signed an executive order for state agencies to enforce the law. While the executive order doesn't apply to city or county agencies, the Governor has strongly urged that they follow suit; and because there are state funds that support most of the nonprofits working in our sector, there is concern that not enforcing the law could negatively impact funding. I encourage you to follow this decision closely, and I will certainly keep you up to date as things unfold in our city. I was quoted in an article from today's <u>Pasadena Now</u>, along with others, expressing concern about the implication of this policy. And my latest <u>podcast episode</u>, which should be live by this evening, is focused on this issue.

We are excited for our upcoming 130th birthday celebration – and are thrilled that over 85 people have already RSVP'd! <u>Please join us</u> and don't miss out on the fun. 
