


Weekly Message

Dear Friend,

On Wednesday evening, we hosted our annual <u>Volunteer</u>
<u>Appreciation BBQ</u>, which is always a fun and festive event. We were thrilled that over 100 people attended, enjoying a lovely evening at Pasadena Presbyterian Church, eating delicious food prepared by our friends at Knights of Columbus, and being together in community.





It is wonderful to see new and seasoned volunteers interact, meeting people who volunteer in different programs, hang out with staff, and celebrate the amazing dedication each person brings to our work at FID. **A huge thank you to Elyse Reed**, one of our Development Associates, who organized and executed a stellar night.

In the spirit of camaraderie, this story from the Food Pantry is a perfect example of how our community lives out our values each day:

Every food distribution day, at 9:00 a.m. sharp, at least one member of the Food Pantry team will hold a lottery at the front of FID House. This has been a longstanding tradition that was implemented to avoid having people line up hours before we open (people used to arrive as early as 5:00 a.m.), people saving places for others, and any arguments about who was first.



Anyone who is here by the time the last ticket is handed out has a chance of being 1st, 2nd, 5th, 20th, 33rd, 58th, etc. Anyone who comes after the first ticket is drawn will have their name added to the sign-in sheet after the lottery has been completed.

But, beyond being a way to keep things in order as more people come to sign in for food, the lottery is a way to get to know our community. When a number is drawn, we call that number out and wait for the person with that number to respond. Then we write their name down on the sign-in sheet. Over time, you begin to be able to put a name to a face, and then call them by name, and everyone likes it when someone remembers them.

The lottery can also be a source of laughter and joking. Our Chinese community loves it when Tim attempts to say the numbers in Mandarin! They applaud or correct him as necessary, and it usually brings merriment to the morning.


